

Invitation of Applications for appointment of Vice-Chancellor, Aryabhata Knowledge University, Patna.

Chancellor's Secretariat, Patna invites applications for appointment of Vice-Chancellor of Aryabhata Knowledge University, Patna.

The **Vice-Chancellor** shall be an academic and scholar of eminence having experience of managing institutions of higher education.

The Vice-Chancellor shall hold office for a term of three years from the date on which he enters upon his office and he shall be eligible for re-appointment for further terms.

Procedure for appointment

- The Vice-Chancellor shall be appointed by the Chancellor from out of a panel of not less than three persons recommended by the three member Search Committee.

The Chancellor's Secretariat invites applications from eligible academicians, for the post of Vice-Chancellor of the Aryabhata Knowledge University, Patna. All necessary details are available on the website of Chancellor's Secretariat, Bihar, **governor.bih.nic.in**.

Interested, eligible individual who has not completed 67 Years of age as on 01st July, 2017 may submit his/her detailed resume in the format alongwith justification for his/her candidature (within 250 words), a vision statement for the University (within 200 words) and names and contact details of three distinguished individuals well acquainted with his/her work.

Interested eligible individuals should apply online on Chancellor's Secretariat website **governor.bih.nic.in**. The Application with all enclosures, should be submitted on or before **20.05.2017 by 06:00 P.M**

Candidates are required to give their e-mail ID at which they would like to receive communication addressed to them including any intimation for interaction with the Search Committee, if required, which may take place in the month of June, 2017.

Search Committee may invite the short listed applicants for a presentation and/or personal interaction, for which no TA/DA shall be paid.

Canvassing, directly or indirectly, by or on behalf of any candidate, in order to bring undue influence upon the selection process, shall attract disqualification.
