

Proceedings of the Meeting of Pro-Vice-Chancellors of the Universities of Bihar held on 31-08-2018 at 11:30 A.M. in Raj Bhavan, Patna

Present:-As per Annexure 1

At the outset, the Principal Secretary to the Governor-cum-Chancellor Shri Vivek Kumar Singh welcomed all Pro-Vice-Chancellors of the Universities of Bihar.

1. The Principal Secretary to Governor-cum-Chancellor emphasized the vital role of Pro-Vice-Chancellors in the affairs of all under graduate examinations and for strict adherence of Examination Calendar submitted by the university.
2. The Pro-Vice-Chancellors were requested to ensure conduct of all pending exams by December, 2018 as per the decision taken in the meeting of Vice-Chancellors held on 30th June, 2018 at Raj Bhavan, Patna. Pro-Vice-Chancellors were requested to ensure submission of required data like date of submission of Forms etc. in the prescribed format regarding conduct of examination etc.
3. In view of delay of conducting exams as per Examination Calendar, the Pro-Vice-Chancellor of BNMU, Madhepura, TMBU, Bhagalpur and Magadh University, Bodh Gaya were asked to submit an enquiry report in this regard within a week, detailing the chronology of events leading to delay and pinpointing responsibility for the same.
4. Some Pro-Vice-Chancellors requested to issue separate directives to clarify their role in Examination Committee and its working. It was unanimously resolved that directions shall be issued for taking support of Pro-Vice-Chancellors in all matters related to examination, publication of results etc. as envisaged in the Act.
5. It was also resolved that Pro-Vice-Chancellors support will be taken by the University in the process of implementation of UMIS from the next Session such as submission of Request For Proposal (RFP), floating of Tender and selection of Vendor etc. and they will be given pre-defined role in implementation of UMIS. They were asked to submit the schedule of implementation with timeline, under the overall supervision of VCs concerned. so that entire process of awarding the tender/selection of vendor could be completed in three months.
6. Some newly appointed Pro-Vice-Chancellors submitted their grievances that no secretarial assistance, vehicle etc have been provided to them causing problem in rendering their official duties. Vice-Chancellors and Registrars are supposed to do the needful for redressal of their genuine grievances.
7. It was also resolved that no appointment will be made on unsanctioned posts in violation of Section 35 of the BSU Act, 1976 and relevant provisions of other Acts. No teachers will be appointed or deputed as OSDs in accordance with the directive issued earlier from Governor's Secretariat, Bihar, Patna vide letter No.-BSU-33/2006-2705/GS(I), dated 02-08-2007.

8. Pro-Vice-Chancellors had been requested to submit at least two suggestions and its solutions to streamline the administrative and academic interest of the University. University wise following suggestions were received :-
