Sub.:- Representation of Shri Bipin Kumar for cancellation of affiliation of K.S.T. Degree College, Salempur, Sohsarai, Nalanda.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to this Secretariat's letter No.MU-38/2009-777/GS(I) dated 20.05.2013 on the subject noted above and to inform that the Hon'ble Chancellor after hearing the concerned party and the University, has been pleased to pass the following order :-

ORDER

In the instant appeal Sri Bipin Kumar & others in their joint representation/ appeal dated 25.3.2009 have prayed for making enquiry and cancellation of affiliation of degree level of KST College, Salempur, Sohsarai, Nalanda.

Briefly stated, the dispute involved in this case is that the State Government in the HRD Department by their letter no. 632, dated 19.3.2008 has allowed KST College, Salempur, Sohsarai, Nalanda (an Intermediate College) affiliation for Graduate Course (Degree level), although the College has no infrastructure for imparting degree level teaching. Aggrieved by the aforesaid decision of the State Government the petitioner Sri Bipin Kumar had moved the Hon'ble Patna High Court in CWJC No. 8273 of 2009 for cancellation of degree level affiliation of the said College and the Hon'ble High Court by order dated 30.7.2009 directed the Hon'ble Chancellor to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 25.3.2009 by passing a reasoned order.

One Shri Binod Prasad had also filed CWJC No. 18495 of 2010 for the same relief which was disposed of by order dated 28.4.2011 requesting the Hon'ble Chancellor to look into the matter and if the report has been received from the University to take a decision after giving opportunity to the concerned parties to be heard. This case has also given rise to MJC No. 5422 of 2011 which is pending before the Hon'ble High Court.

In course of hearing inspite of notice, both Shri Bipin Kumar and Shri Binod Parsad were not present. However the representative of the University and Education Department, Govt of Bihar as well as Principal of the aforesaid College were present.

After considering the representation of the petitioners as well as the report of the Three Men Committee submitted by the University, orders of the Hon'ble High Court referred to above and after hearing the concerned parties present in the hearing, it has been found that the KST College, Salempur, Sohsarai, Nalanda has sufficient infrastructure and other requisite requirements for imparting Graduate level teaching and the College has rightly been granted degree level affiliation vide State Govt's letter no. 632, dated 19.3.2008.

Therefore, the representation under reference lacks merit and is hereby rejected.
