Sub: - Regarding measures to be followed in the Universities of Bihar in view of COVID-19 pandemic

Sir,

Please refer to Order no. 40-3/2020-DM-1(A) of Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India and Order no.-जी/आपदा-06-02/2020-317/अ.मु.स.को. of Home Department, Government of Bihar on the subject cited above. The Guidelines of the Ministry of Home Affairs (annexed with the aforementioned order) state as follows:

"Schools, Colleges, Educational / Training / Coaching Institutions etc., will be opened after consultations with States & UTs. State Governments, UT Administrations may hold consultaions at the Instituions level with parents and other Stakeholders. Based on the feedback, a decision on the re-opening of these institutions will be taken of the month July, 2020."

In light of the above guidelines, the Hon'ble Chancellor of the Universities of Bihar has been pleased to direct that the Universities of Bihar shall re-open only after a decision in this regard is taken at the level of the Central Government and State Government and communicated to all concerned.

In the meantime, the Universities of State should continue the online education of Students through interactive classes and uploadation of e-contents (including video lectures and study materials) so that there may be minimum disruption in the education of students and sessions are completed on time. Information about the online education should be regularly uploaded on the websites of the Universities and weekly reports may be sent to the Chancellor's Secretariat.
